Any briefing notes or other relevant documentation in relation to engagements between Minister for Foreign Affairs and Trade, Ministers of State within the Department or Department staff and Ruhama or its representatives from 2010 to present.

I refer also to the acknowledgement of your request which was sent to you on 26 March 2019.

I have identified four records that fall within the scope of your request. The records are listed in the schedule attached. I have made a decision to grant the records.

## Right of Appeal
