I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

**I am submitting a Freedom of Information request under the 2014 Freedom of Information Act for copies of records listing Civic Society Organisations receiving aid in the sums of between €50,000 and € 100,000 in the year 2017 and the amounts they received. The 2017 Irish Aid Annual Report lists recipients of sums of €100 K and over which is a departure from previous policy of listing recipients of € 50 K and over.**

I refer also to the acknowledgement of your request which was sent to you on the 30<sup>th</sup> of September 2019.

I am pleased to provide you with details of Civil Society Organisations which received funding of amounts between €50,000 and €100,000 through Irish Aid in 2017.


