I refer also to the acknowledgement of your request which was sent to you on 27 February 2020.

I have identified 6 records that fall within the scope of your request. The records are listed in the schedule attached. I have made a decision to grant access to records 1 – 6. The information redacted from record 6 contains bank details which appear not to be in the

public domain. This redaction has no impact on the substance of the information contained therein, so I consider your request granted in full.

Right of Appeal

You should make your appeal within 4 weeks (20 working days) from the date of this notification. However, the making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances. The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this Department.
