Dear Ms Brayden,

I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

I refer also to the acknowledgement of your request which was sent to you on 6 March 2020.

I have identified three records that fall within the scope of your request. The records are listed in the schedule attached. I have made a decision to grant two of the records, and partgrant one of the records. The part-granted record is an email which includes contact details of the correspondent. The contact details have been redacted under the relevant exemption Section 37 – Personal information; the rest of the email has been granted.

Right of Appeal
