I refer to the request which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department.

Taxis


Rail/Train/Luas/Bus Tickets

3: A full list of expenses and the amount by the Minister for 2018

The only expense paid to the Minister in the year to date was subsistence in the amount of epsilon 1,509.70. Where meals were provided for they are deducted from subsistence at the appropriate rate.
