The total amount of money the Department spent on cleaning companies/contractors since the current Government came to power in 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015 (up to the date of your letter). Please state the total per year and the amount paid to each contractor in each year.

I am releasing the records listed in the attached schedule in respect of 9 premises occupied by the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade in Dublin, Cork and Limerick as agreed with you by the Freedom of Information Manager, Ms Frances Kiernan, in the course of clarification of your request. The records are an extract from the Department's accounts. The payments to the companies listed cover cleaning of premises together with a range of related services and supplies, including removal of waste and recycling.
